
It's with great pleasure that we share our successes and results from the previous year. As anticipated, we doubled our facility space with the June opening of the KACS Resource Center. But that is just the beginning. KACS took another step in our journey to go from an immediate crisis agency to one that also walks a journey with families to build lasting stability.

This was a year that we continued to transform program delivery to reach the most vulnerable members of our community. The Resource Center provides a welcoming place for those that are homeless and marginalized to bathe and launder clothing. In the process of fulfilling this most basic need, they discover acceptance and healthy relationships with people that genuinely care about their well-being.


Over the past two years, volunteers and staff began to look beyond food insecurity to gain a deeper understanding of the unique challenges faced by those living in a recurrent state of crisis, and in some cases, chronic homelessness. The Resource Center was created to be a co-locating facility, providing space for partner agencies to deliver a multitude of services in a community-based setting. Now KACS participants can access employment and legal services, family benefits, computer classes and more – right in their own neighborhood.

KACS leadership began to address the issue of poverty with a fresh approach by launching the Bridges Out of Poverty initiative. We firmly believe that everyone in Southern Chester County can achieve quality of life and play a part in building a healthy community. The effectiveness of this model depends on collaboration across every sector. We are excited to bring the Bridges philosophy to the region and are pleased that many groups are joining the effort to build pathways for economic mobility.

The successes of the last year reflect a dedication and passion of a community that cares. We are grateful that you have joined us in this work – keeping the Cupboard filled and helping us provide safe, warm housing for local families and individuals. With our deepest appreciation, we thank you!

The Kennett Food Cupboard

At a Glance

- ♦ 786 Families received food at the Food Cupboard throughout the year, including 1,030 Children, 1,072 Adults & 243 Seniors
- ♦ Families selected an average of 120 lbs. of nutritious food on monthly trips to the Cupboard
- ♦ 42,900 lbs. of food moved through the Kennett Food Cupboard monthly
- ♦ In cooperation with the Kennett Consolidated School District, 380 students received nutrition assistance through the Summer program
- ♦ 94% of Food Cupboard visitors enrolled in the Healthy Options program to secure additional healthy nutrition and participate in Case Management services to gain resources and minimize food insecurity



- ♦ 92% of food is provided through local grocers, partner agencies and local food drives
- ♦ \$25,000 of fresh meats, dairy and produce are purchased by KACS for consistent, quality nutrition
- ♦ 86 food drives helped to fill the Cupboard throughout the year
- ♦ Thanks to our volunteers & partners, 100 seniors receive home delivery each month

Emergency Assistance

At a Glance

KACS became a provider for Homeless Prevention and Rapid Rehousing in 2013. Since that time, 150 homeless households were given shelter and secured safe, permanent housing by working with KACS Case Managers.

With the opening of the KACS Resource Center, the homeless have a place to bathe, launder clothing, obtain basic food assistance and most importantly - find a community of people ready to help.

Our Emergency Assistance program continues to provide financial assistance and homeless prevention services to stop a crisis before it's too late.

The KACS Resource Center also houses six partner agencies, bringing additional resources and one-stop shopping to the community. Another three agencies and community groups utilize the Resource Center for meetings, mobile client visits and more.

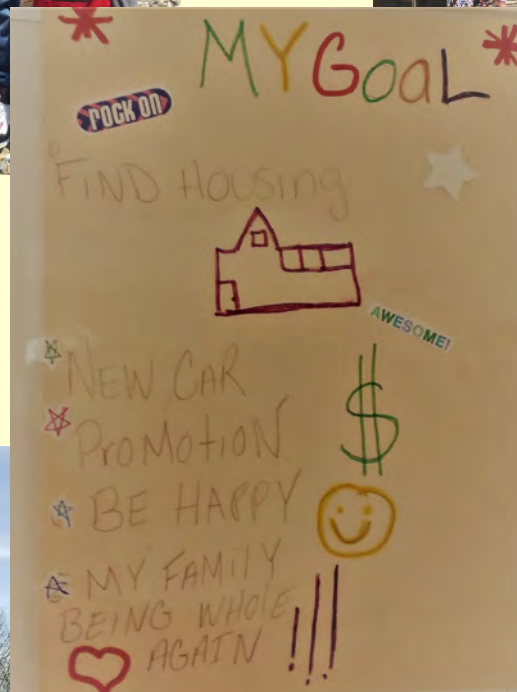


In 2016

- ♦ KACS provided motel room fees for 236 nights
- ♦ 45 homeless households secured permanent housing through KACS
- ♦ 40 families received homeless prevention services to avoid eviction or utility shut off
- ♦ 44 heating oil tanks were filled
- ♦ \$10,984 was paid for security deposits for rental housing
- ♦ Homeless Prevention & Rapid Rehousing services provided to the homeless in Kennett Square, Avondale, West Grove, Oxford and Nottingham
- ♦ 92% remain housed for 12 months
- ♦ Overall, \$121,195 was provided to support 860 people in need

Sustainability Programs

At a Glance

- ♦ Launched the Bridges Out of Poverty classes for professionals and the community
- ♦ Trained 80 community members and 35 partner agency staff about creating a community of opportunity for under-resourced families
- ♦ In September, KACS launched the first 'Getting Ahead-in-a-Just-Gettin'-by-World' Class
- ♦ 23 participants joined these classes to learn about each of 11 resources needed to find economic mobility
- ♦ Installed 9 raised bed gardens to provide gardening workshops and much needed produce for the Food Cupboard
- ♦ Conducted 18 Nutrition Workshops with recipes and food sampling for families when they visit the Cupboard
- ♦ Hosted 8 Agency partners in the Resource Center to provide family benefit assistance, employment resources and CareerLink, legal services and more

- ♦ Hundreds of volunteer hours were donated in the planning and renovation of the new KACS Resource Center, from demolition to painting to the garden installation—the Resource Center is a community place!
- ♦ 1,000+ volunteer hours are worked every month
- ♦ 400 volunteers organize and work events to serve 650 families
- ♦ Volunteers provide service in every area of the operation - leadership, serving, reception, driving, sorting, cleaning, administrative work, data & trends analysis, special projects and so much more.
- ♦ Over 400 volunteers participated in the assembly and distribution of the 63th Annual Christmas Basket program, providing a wonderful holiday to 650 families
- ♦ 25 volunteer groups, employers, scouts, churches and more, completed projects at KACS

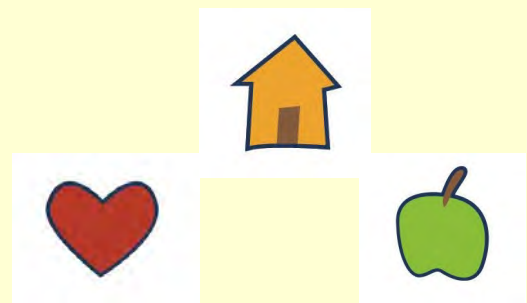
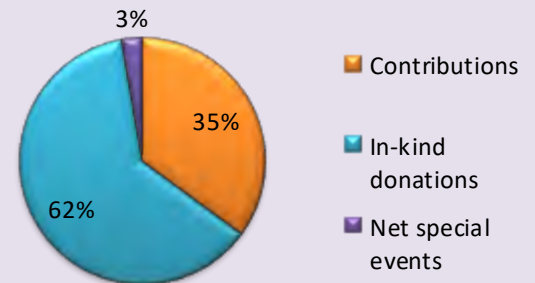

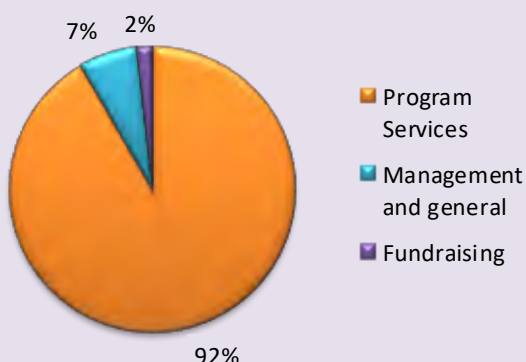
