## Food Cupboard **\$5,000,000**

This unique and special naming opportunity encompasses KACS' entire community food program.	This area is the home base for our caseworkers, who provide information and referrals, emergency assistance, homelessness prevention and diversion, housing stability, and our NEW Housing Initiative. These programs together reach more than 1,700 people each year.	This large new warehouse area will empower KACS to serve as a food distribution center for other organizations across the area, as well as store more food for our own Food Cupboard participants.	This area is where our food cupboard participants select their food, which will be seen by more than 5,000 people each year.

This large classroom will serve as our meeting place for KACS Bridges Out of Poverty workshops for adults in the community. These include Getting Ahead, Staying Ahead, and Financial Literacy workshops.	This area will serve housing-insecure residents of our community with essential services such as shower and laundry facilities.	This area will be comprised of office spaces dedicated to community partners who offer complementary services to KACS.	This office is the workplace for our Executive Director and is seen by most visitors to KACS.

Our largest conference room will host meetings and trainings for KACS as well as community meetings hosted by partner agencies and collaborating groups.	This waiting room will be visited by more than 5,000 people a year as they get ready to enter the Food Cupboard Shopping Area.	The volunteer break room will be a hub for the 120+ volunteers who work at our Food Cupboard. Volunteers will have a place to take a break and a place for meetings and training.	The staff break room will be a daily gathering location for KACS' staff as well as the staff of partner agencies using the partner offices at KACS and the agencies occupying the tenant space.

This room serves as the hub for the cleaning, packing, and processing of perishable foods for our participants.	This waiting room will be visited by more than 1,600 people a year as they get ready to meet with our social services staff for emergency and housing assistance.	These two conference rooms will be daily resources for KACS to meet with larger families, small department-level staff meetings, meetings with donors and supporters, Board committee meetings, and meetings with partner agencies sharing cases with KACS to help bring more support to families.	Three loading docks, including one car dock, will serve as resources for loading food into KACS Food Distribution Warehouse and for the unloading of food to deliver to other food-providing organizations or groups in the region.

The deadline to secure the named sponsorship opportunities above will be May 31, 2025. Unless otherwise stated, there is one of each opportunity available, so the first commitment will secure the naming opportunity.
